Members of Shoreline Credit Union:

I am pleased to announce an update related to *Project Unify*, which has included both a consolidation of our Memorial Drive branch as well as a significant remodel of our historic branch on Mishicot Road.

Friday, November 3 will be the final day of operation for our branch at 2848 Memorial Drive, Two Rivers. We wish to extend a sincere thank you to the members who have supported this branch for the past 20 years. The property is currently listed for sale with a local broker.

Around the week of November 20, a Mobile Bank Facility (MBF) will be placed at our Mishicot Road branch. The purpose of the MBF is as follows:

- Provide a more convenient location for our membership to transact inside a branch during the remodel.
- Provide our staff a quieter, safer branch to work at during the remodel project.
- Provide our construction workers full access to the branch during the remodel, which allows the project to be completed in a few weeks rather than a few months.
- Provide an ADA-Compliant access point for our members to continue to bank with Shoreline.

From the date of delivery to about the second week of December, the MBF will be non-operational as Shoreline staff transitions from the branch to the MBF and the set-up process is completed. **Please be aware of traffic pattern changes within the Shoreline parking lot during this time.**

Construction is slated to begin in December. Once the construction begins, please note that **all in-branch activity will be transitioned to the MBF**. This includes accessing your account, opening accounts, and working with our consumer/mortgage lenders. Doors to the branch will be locked, and restrooms will not be available. Construction should be completed by early Spring, 2018.

During the majority of the remodel project, all three lanes of the drive-thru will remain open. There will be a three-day period where the drive-thru will be closed. We will announce those days once they have been established.
